Tournament Rules:

- Players will start with 20,000 in tournament chips.
- Levels will last 30 minutes each. Final Table will be 40 minutes. Seating may be limited for this event. * Turbo Flights, Levels will last 20 minutes each.
- Dinner Break will be from 6:30pm - 7:10pm
- 3pm Flights On-Site Registration and unlimited Re-Entries are available until the start of Level 9 of this event. Approximately 7:30pm.
- 7pm Flights On-Site Registration and unlimited Re-Entries are available until the start of Level 9 of this event. Approximately 10:15pm.
- Players may register for Day 43A, 43B, 43C, 43D, 43E, 43F, 43G, 43H, and/or Day 43I. If player entered into any starting day has been eliminated from the Tournament, they may Re-Enter the flight and/or register for any subsequent starting day(s).
- A player who advances to Day 2 is prohibited from entering a subsequent starting flight. A player that has advanced to Day 2 who enters a starting flight in error will be disqualified from the subsequent flight and will not be entitled to a refund of their Tournament re-entry. The player will be permitted to play Day with their Tournament chip stack from the original starting flight.

- The Tournament will reward participants for eliminating another player (the "Bounty"). Each player who eliminates a Bounty from the Tournament will receive a prize from the bounty prize pool. The bounties will begin on Day 2. There will be no bounties awarded on Day 1.
- All Tournament and bounty prizes are included in the Tournament guaranteed prize pool of \$300,000.
- Mystery Bounty prizes will range in value from \$300 to \$250,000. Bounties will be redeemed with Tournament Payouts.
- If the number of paid entries does not generate at least the Guaranteed prize pool, after the deduction of the Tournament fees and service charge \$200,000 of the Guarantee will be designated for the Tournament prize pool, and \$100,000 of the Guarantee will be designated for the Bounty prize pool. Any prize pool generated above \$300,000 will be split 60% into the Tournament prize pool and 40% into the mystery bounty prize pool.
- If multiple players eliminate a Bounty with the same winning hand, all players with a Tournament chip count equal to or greater than the eliminated Bounty prior to the start of the hand will equally split the corresponding Bounty prize.
- Day 1 will end once the field has reached 10% rounded up. All Day 2 players will be in the money. At the beginning of Day 2, the Tournament clock will resume at the earliest finishing time at which play ended in any of the previous starting flights. Day 2 will be played until the completion of the event. A third day may be added if all players unanimously agree once the final table is reached.
- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for each hand. If a participant doesn't have enough to post both, the big blind and the ante, the big blind will be posted first.
- Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack and no obligation from it.
- Redraw at the end of Day 1. Redraw will also occur at 27 and 9 players or at Tournament Directors discretion
- TDA and House Rules apply. Tournament Directors decisions are final and without recourse.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament. Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material pertaining to this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- Winners will be paid in casino chips.
- All tax laws foreign and domestic apply. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount)
- Tournament prize pools may be modified if one table remains. All players must unanimously agree.
- \$290 will go into the prize pool. \$60 is withheld for house administrative and staff fee.
- All unredeemed payouts, including mystery bounties past 90 days of the initial date of the tournament payout, those funds will be surrendered to the Grand Poker Series revenue.
